## **Project Level**

Easy

## **Materials**

Lion Brand Cobblestone Yarn (3.5oz./100g; 219yds/200m; 100% Acrylic) - 1 skein

5.5mm crochet hook

Stitch Marker

Measuring tape

Yarn Needle

Scissors

## **Gauge/Measurements**

16 ½ hdcblo x 10 rows= 4x4 in Square (10.2cm)

### **Laid Flat w/ brim folded:**

9” width x 10” height

## **Stitches/Abbreviations**

**Chain-** ch                      **Half Double Crochet-** hdc                      **Stitch-** st

**Slip Stitch-** sl st              **Half Double Crochet Back Loop Only-** hdcblo

## **Pattern Notes:**

- Ch 1 **does not** count as a stitch in this pattern.
- Beanie is constructed in rows and slip stitches into a center ring.

- When creating the center ring be sure to leave a 10in. tail to crochet over. This will be used to seam the top of your beanie closed.
- Place the stitch marker in the last stitch you made in the row throughout the pattern. This will help you not skip over the stitch after turning your work.

## **Pattern**

Ch 14, sl st to create a ring.

**Row 1:** Ch 53. Hdc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each st across. Place your stitch marker in last st and sl st into the ring. Turn, ch 1. (52)

**Row 2:** Hdc in 1<sup>st</sup> , place stitch marker, hdcblo each st across until 1 st remain, hdc in last st. Turn, ch 1.

**Row 3-** Hdc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, hdcblo each st across. Hdc in last st, place stitch marker in st, sl st into the ring. Turn, ch 1.

**Rows 4-44:** Repeat rows 2 & 3. Fasten off leaving 32in tail for seaming.

## **Finishing**

With yarn needle threaded, fold beanie in half so that the stitches from both sides match. Mattress stitch your beanie together. Fasten off.

Next, turn your beanie inside out. Find the 10in tail you crocheted over and pull tight to close the top of your beanie. Whip stitch closed. Fasten off and weave in all ends. Turn your beanie to the right side and fold your brim.
